## The LIFE CERSUDS Regional Working Group holds its fourth meeting at ITC

• The members of the Regional Working Group of the LIFE CERSUDS project met at ITC, as project coordinator, on Friday, 10 November 2017, to learn about the progress of the project and discuss, among other things, its replicability.

Castellón, November 1th 2017.- The Institute of Ceramic Technology (ITC) as coordinator of the LIFE CERSUDS Ceramic Sustainable Urban Drainage System project, today brought together some 20 people, members of the project's Regional Working Group. This is already the fourth meeting of the GTRLC, made up of representatives of municipalities, universities, research centres, companies and public bodies, with the aim of promoting a change of model in cities when it comes to finding sustainable solutions for urban drainage.

On this occasion, the description of the project prepared by the architects Enrique Fernández-Vivancos and Eduardo de Miguel was discussed. The first was present at this meeting to explain the characteristics of the GTRLC, while Javier Mira, principal investigator of LIFE CERSUDS at ITC, explained the characteristics of the C/Torre San Vicente demonstrator, whose on-site testing began in October. The characteristics of the monitoring plan have also been explained by members of the UPV's IIAMA, while Javier Mira has subsequently explained the possibilities of replicability of LIFE CERSUDS, an item that forms part of the project given that it is considered essential that the advances made in this work can be carried out in other cities and municipalities, achieving benefits for localities and citizens in the interests
