The Regional Working Group of the LIFE CERSUDS project will hold its fifth meeting in Benicàssim

Experts and representatives of city councils, universities, research centres, companies and public bodies that are part of the regional working group of the LIFE CERSUDS Project meet in Benicassim to make progress on the Project and visit the works of the demonstrator.

Castellón, May 3rd 2018.- The Casa de la Cultura of Benicàssim, the municipality where the demonstrator of the European project LIFE CERSUDS (Ceramic Sustainable Urban Drainage System) is being built, will host the fifth meeting of the Regional Working Group on 4 May, which brings together representatives of town councils, universities, research centres, companies and public bodies, who share the objective of promoting a change of model in cities when seeking sustainable urban drainage solutions.

In this new session, in addition to presenting recent activities of the project, which began work on the demonstrator last February, the replicability of the same will also be addressed, as it is planned to prepare two preliminary projects for the LIFE CERSUDS system, financed by the European Union's LIFE 2014-2020 Environment and Climate Action Programme (Ref: LIFE 15 CCA/ES/000091), which would be replicated in Italy and Portugal.

At the end of this fifth meeting, the Regional Working Group of the LIFE CERSUDS project is scheduled to visit the civil works in progress on Calle Torre Sant Vicent in Benicàssim (Castellón).
